## Money's Worth/Real Estate

Ski season typically runs from September to April. Given the country saw its first 2006/2007 snowfall two weeks ago in some popular ski resort towns, here are three homes at ski resorts. —Sheree R. Curry



**PLACE/PRICE** Teton Springs  
Teton Valley, Idaho  
\$1.19 million

**THE PROPERTY** 3 bedrooms, 3½ baths, 2,502 square feet

**DESCRIPTION** There is a stone fireplace in the open great room. A farmhouse-style kitchen has granite countertops and stainless-steel appliances. There is also wireless Internet access, custom lighting and a large deck.

**NOTABLE** This log home with attached garage offers views of the 11th Fairway and is against the Targhee National Forest. The resort offers "top to bottom" heli-skiing and is about 25 miles from Grand Targhee and Jackson Hole.



**THE LODGES AT SNOWCREEK RESORT**  
Mammoth Lakes, Calif.  
\$1.78 million

**THE PROPERTY** 3 bedrooms, 3½ baths, 2,739 square feet

**DESCRIPTION** The master has a golf course view, a fireplace and a walk-in closet. A loft looks over a living room with a vaulted ceiling and a fireplace. The kitchen has a serving island and a walk-in pantry.

**NOTABLE** This ranch-style town home with multiple decks is in the Snowcreek Resort, which offers cross-country skiing, golf, tennis and fishing. It is near Mammoth Mountain, which had 632 inches of snow last season.



**THE CLUB AT SPANISH PEAKS**  
Big Sky, Mt.  
\$3.79 million

**THE PROPERTY** 5 bedrooms, 4½ baths, 5,050 square feet

**DESCRIPTION** This furnished barnwood and timber home has rock fireplaces in the master suite and great room. There is a theater room, mud room with ski-equipment storage and there is a guest apartment.

**NOTABLE** This home on three acres with views of the Gallatin Range is just minutes from the Club's Big Sky Resort private lift, which has an average 400-inch snowfall, 23 lifts, 220 runs and 4,350 feet of vertical drop.
